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1. Abstract

2. purpose


The purpose of this study is to find ways to spend comfortable time in shelters when disasters happen and to know the student's awareness of disaster prevention.

We investigated whether the cardboards can decrease the risks of the infection or not, and we did the survey about the awareness of disaster prevention.




How much water should you bring ?



How much food should you bring ?




Have you prepared anything to bring to the shelter?
